Safety While Travelling

1. Safety is very important while travelling. There are many ways to travel. For pedestrians, the roads can be very busy and many people do not look before crossing the road. Children can jump into the road because they don't know the road rules - 20% of children who are in accidents are pedestrians.
2. When driving a car, everyone must wear a seatbelt and watch for traffic signs. Research shows that wearing a seatbelt can increase driver's safety by 50%. Also, depending on the city, many types of transport travel on the same roads- for example, "tuk tuks", buses and trams. The driver must be careful at all times.
3. If riding a motorbike, the rider must wear a helmet and put on bright clothes so that cars can see them clearly - it is 5 times harder for people to see a bike than a car. Motorbikes can be fun, but, on main roads at high speeds, they are at 30 times more likely to get into an accident than in a car!
